The 10% Challenge invites you to discover some of the spots in Red Hook which are helping our community to decrease its energy use, enjoy the fruits of our fields and reduce our consumption. Once the form has been completed, drop it at the library. Completed forms will be entered into a drawing to receive a **\$25 gift card to Flat Iron**. Part 1: Match the following descriptions to the numbered locations on the map on the back of this sheet.

- 1 I was built in the 1760s and am a community meeting place where Winter Market is held.
- 2 I am one of the two official spots where the Dutchess County Loop bus stops (though you can flag the bus down from other spots). You can get Red Hook info while you wait.
- 3 Red Hook has been designated a "Tree City USA." I am one of the many trees the Village Green Committee and Town of Red Hook Tree Preservation Commission have planted. Hint: there's a marker and I am across from where Winter Market is held.
- 4 We have recently acquired solar electric panels, saving tax payer money and reducing greenhouse gas emissions.
- 5 Stop by here to buy green cleaning products that don't contaminate our water.
- 6 At this farm stand, one of many in Red Hook, you can buy local produce, yummy cider, and bring home some baked goods.
- 7 Reduce your energy bill by line drying with a clothesline and pins purchased at this store in the Village center.
- 8 This is the ultimate place to borrow and reuse reading, audio and video materials.
- 9 Red Hook recycles on Apple Blossom Day and throughout the year. Now that the Village has gone single stream, you can put paper and containers together in the recycling bin located there (bin out for special events only).
- 10 At this spot, you are able to grow your own food, socialize with neighbors, and compost to your heart's content.
